



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
What is your current class standing at UCSC?



Why are you taking this class?




What percentage of class activities or meetings did you participate in? (Note: 1 week = 10%)





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
About how many total hours per week, outside of class meetings, did you spend on work for this course?

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


The instructor communicated clearly and explained concepts effectively.


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


The instructor clearly communicated how assignments would be evaluated and/or graded.



The instructor helped me find ways to engage with course content.




